Baby	4 - 6 months
Puppy	6 - 9 months
Junior	9 - 18 months
Intermediate	15 - 24 months
Open	from 15 months
Working	from 15 months – dogs with working certificate
Winner	from 15 months – dogs with recognized International or National Championship, National Winners, Club Winners, Specialty Winners, European Winners, World Winners
Honorary	from 15 months – dogs with recognized International or National Championship, National Winners, Club Winners, Specialty Winners, European Winners, World Winners, without title
Veteran	from 8 years

The age of the dog at the day of the show is decisive for entering a certain class.

Titles awarded:

- CAJC – may be granted to male and female with Excellent 1 in Junior Class
- CAC – may be granted to male and female with Excellent 1 in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner Class
- Res. CAC – may be granted to male and female with Excellent 2 in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner Class
- Specialty Winner – compete males and females with granted CAC title
- Best of Juniors (BOJ) + Junior Specialty Winner
 - compete male and female with granted CAJC title
- Best of Veterans (BOV) + Veteran Specialty Winner
 - compete male and female with Excellent 1 in Veteran Class
- Best of Breed (BOB) – compete males and females with granted CAJC, Specialty Winner title and Excellent 1 in Veteran Class and Honorary Class
- Best of Opposite Sex (BOS)

Awarding of the titles is not obligatory. The titles are recorded in the dog's pedigree with the approval of the exhibitor. Club membership isn't needed for awarding of the titles.

Awards: Every dog exhibited will get a judge's critique in the show ring. Title holders, competition winners and the first four dogs in every class will get a prize in the ring after the judging. Records will be written in the dog's pedigree after the end of judging.

Every exhibitor will get a printed catalogue in the show ring.

When entering more than one dog of the same owner, the dog in baby, puppy, junior, honorary or veteran class must be considered as the second and other dog and pays the fee stated for baby, puppy, junior, honorary or veteran class.

If the exhibitor doesn't attend the show for any reason, the entry fee won't be returned.

General conditions:

- The Specialty Show is open for every Welsh Corgi Pembroke, Welsh Corgi Cardigan and Australian kelpie registered in FCI stud book.
- **Admittance of a dog will be confirmed by Dogoffice and a variable symbol for the payment will be assigned.**
- The organizer isn't liable for any damages caused by the dog or the exhibitor, or for the dog's death or loss.
- Upon receipt of the application, the exhibitor is subject to FCI show rules, ČMKU rules, show conditions and the show committee directions.
- Highly pregnant females, breastfeeding females and dogs which have undergone surgery to alter the dog's appearance are excluded from the show.
- If the show is cancelled due to objective reasons, all collected fees will be used to cover show expenses.
- Selling puppies at the show is forbidden.
- The exhibitor grants a permission to have his or her address published in the show catalogue.
- **Judges list changes reserved!**
- Unless otherwise specified, the provisions of the FCI international show rules and ČMKU rules shall apply.

Protests:

Objections against decisions made by judges are not permissible. Formal complaints concerning violation of show rules or conditions can be filed. Such complaint must be submitted in written form against the deposit of 1500 CZK at the show office during judging in the ring. If the protest is found to be unjustified, the deposit will be forfeited to the show organizer. Later protests won't be accepted.

Veterinary conditions:

- All dogs attending the show must be clinically healthy.
- Dogs must be immune to rabies. (They were vaccinated, according to the manufacturer of the vaccine, 21 days to 1-3 years before the day of the show).
- Dogs from the Czech Republic must have valid certificate of vaccination (§ 6 veterinary law), or valid Pet Pass. Dogs from the EU and third countries must meet the conditions of the EU Regulation 576/2013 from 12/6/2013.
